What are the basic expenses involved in an Interactive Franchise?

The basic expenses involved in an Interactive Franchise are similar to other Franchises and they include but are not limited to: Initiation, Startup, Advertising and Marketing Fees, Training, License, Legal and Royalty Fees.

What is the initial investment needed to obtain an Interactive Franchise?

Each potential Candidate(s) have 3 areas of investment. A Preliminary Agreement Deposit of \$5000. The balance of your Funding Franchise Agreement (depending on territory and size) and a fixed percentage amount for opening your Bank account (depending on sales forecast) and liquidity requirements.

Does Interactive Interiors offer any financial programs?

Interactive Interiors does not currently offer any financial programs, however most chartered banks have favorable loans fees for small-med business. You may also refer to local investment firms for financial advice on attaining one of our Franchises.

What Geographical regions are available for franchising?

Most locations within the United States are still available for franchisees. However Interactive Interiors will review with you the opportunities available at the time, to ensure you capitalize aggressively and successfully in your chosen territory.

How many employees does it take to start up an Interactive Franchise?

An Interactive Interiors Franchise requires at least 2 Full-time Employees and can require up to 8 additional employees either full or part time. A Marketing and Sales Organizational person and a Technical and Project Oriented person are the 2 key ingredients. Interactive can recommend additional personnel in your area if your fall short of this criteria.
