## Security

One of the most common aspects of the smart home is Security. Security in a Smart Home starts with basic door and window contacts. You can then add motion detectors, glass breaks, carbon and smoke detectors to give you an all around secure system. For those of you who add more features, CCTV and other discrete cameras can be located around the interior and exterior of your home. An intercom system can be placed at your front door along with a camera, so that when the doorbell rings an image of the person can be displayed on your TV or computer.

You also have the option to be notified when you system has been breached either by cellular connection or pager.

For piece of mind CCTV Cameras can be mounted in your babies' room given you access throughout the home either by sight or sound.

In order for a Home Management System to fully function, Security can be integrated with Lighting Controls to maximize your safety. In case of fire or serious alarm problems, lights can show you the way to safety and exterior lights can notify neighbours of potential problems.

Wired or wireless options for Security components depend on the locations being installed. For a new home it is essential to hardwire security systems, to ensure 100% reliability. For existing homes wireless options ensure safety, but incur more false alarms.
